

## AWPGA AGILITY AWARD PROGRAM

The AWPGA Agility Award program was created to encourage participation in the sport and to reward those Wirehaired Pointing Griffons who exhibit admirable ability in the sport of dog agility. The AWPGA Agility award program utilizes the three major sanctioning agility organizations, AKC, NADAC and USDAA for dogs who compete in the sport of dog agility.

AWPGA Agility awards are open to all Wirehaired Pointing Griffons who are owned by AWPGA members in good standing. Board of Directors, Officers and Awards & Recognition Committee member owned dogs are eligible for all awards.

All applicants must use the official agility application forms with the appropriate documentation submitted. Application deadline is May 1<sup>st</sup>.

All applications and qualifying points will be verified by the Awards & Recognition Committee.

### *AWPGA AGILITY DOG HALL OF FAME AWARD*

This award was created to honor those Wirehaired Pointing Griffons of the past and present who have displayed superior achievements in the sport of dog agility.

### *AWPGA AGILITY DOG OF THE YEAR AWARD*

The AWPGA will reward the Wirehaired Pointing Griffon who has accumulated the greatest number of agility points in a calendar year.

## AWPGA Agility Dog Hall of Fame Award

The AWPGA Agility Hall of Fame Award is open to any Wirehaired Pointing Griffon, of the past and present, who has accumulated fifteen (15) points or more in a lifetime, based on his performance in American Kennel Club (AKC) and/or North American Dog Agility Council (NADAC), and/or United States Dog Agility Association (USDAA) agility trials, will be honored in the AWPGA Agility Hall of Fame. Qualifying points will come from the AWPGA Agility Dog Point Schedule. Qualifying dogs will receive this award only once.

Criteria for entrance into the AWPGA Agility Dog Hall of Fame.

1. Fifteen (15) agility points minimum total
2. Points will come from the Agility Point Schedule
3. Send completed & signed official application submitted with appropriate documentation to the Awards & Recognition Committee by May 1st.
4. Open to all dogs owned by AWPGA members in good standing.

Qualifying points will be verified by the Awards & Recognition Committee

## AWPGA Agility Dog of the Year Award

The AWPGA Agility Dog of the Year Award was created to recognize each year, the Wirehaired Pointing Griffon who has achieved the greatest qualifications in the sport of dog agility within a calendar year.

Open to any dog owned by AWPGA members in good standing who have met the required four (4) point minimum from his performance in American Kennel Club (AKC), North American Dog Agility Council (NADAC) and/or United States Dog Agility Association (USDAA). The dog who has accumulated the highest number of qualifying points within a calendar year; January 1<sup>st</sup> through December 31<sup>st</sup> from the AWPGA Agility Dog Point Schedule will be the winner. Members may apply for this award numerous times.

2. All requirements must be met by December 31<sup>st</sup>
3. Send completed & signed official application submitted with appropriate documentation to the Awards & Recognition Committee by May 1<sup>st</sup>
