

AWPGA VERSATILITY AWARD PROGRAM

The purpose of the AWPGA Versatility Awards is to encourage participation in the various canine activities and to reward those Wirehaired Pointing Griffons who have the flexibility in both mind and body to achieve various titles in diverse disciplines.

The Versatile Griffon (VG) and the Versatile Griffon Excellent (VGX) are awarded to those Wirehaired Pointing Griffons who have earned the required points from the following groups:

- Field (group A)
- Obedience (group B)
- Performance (group C)
- Tracking (group D)
- Conformation (group E)
- Other (group F)

AWPGA Versatility Awards are open to all Wirehaired Pointing Griffons who are owned by AWPGA members in good standing. Board of Directors, Officers and Awards & Recognition Committee member owned dogs are eligible for all awards.

All applicants must use the official Versatility Application which must be signed, dated and submitted with appropriate documentation and sent to the Awards & Recognition Committee by May 1st. Qualifications must be met by December 31st.

AWPGA VERSATILE GRIFFON (VG)

Open to all Wirehaired Pointing Griffons who have attained points out of a choice of six (6) Groups which include, field, obedience, performance, tracking, conformation and other events. Dogs may receive this award only once.

AWPGA VERSATILE GRIFFON EXCELLENT (VGX)

A lifetime of accomplishments from a variety of dog sports and competitions make this award an elite honor to those Wirehaired Pointing Griffons and their owners who have shown exceptional ability and flexibility to acquire a collection of titles. Open to all dogs who have the AWPGA Versatile Griffon (VG) and who have been OFA'd. Dogs may receive this award only once.

AWPGA Versatile Griffon (VG)

Requirements:

1. Eight (8) versatile points minimum total.

2. Above Eight (8) points must be obtained from no less than four (4) of the above 6 groups.
3. Two (2) point minimum must come from Group A (field)
4. Points are not accumulative in any one group (i.e., a UD entitles a dog to four (4) points. His CDX and CD cannot be added).
5. Applicants must use the official versatility application form submitted with all necessary documentation by May 1st to the Awards & Recognition Committee.

The following are acceptable as documentation for title/awards required for the AWPGA Versatile Griffon and AWPGA Versatile Griffon Excellent Awards.

- For all AKC titles/points (hunt tests, obedience, agility, Rally and conformation): any of the following
- Photocopy of AKC title certificate
 - Photocopy of "New Title" listing in AKC Awards publication
 - Photocopy of dog's official test/title record provided by AKC

For all NADAC titles:

Photocopy of title certificate

For all NAVHDA test qualifications:

Photocopy of test record provided by NAVHDA

For all NSTRA trial points:

Photocopy of trial activity provided by NSTRA

AWPGA Versatile Griffon Excellent (VGX)

Requirements:

1. Fifteen (15) versatile points minimum total including the following:
 - a. An AWPGA Versatile Griffon Award (VG)
 - b. A minimum of three (3) points are required from Group A (Field)
 - c. A minimum of three (3) points are required from Group B (obedience)
 - d. A minimum of three (3) points are required from Group E (conformation)
2. The requirements of (3) points from Group E (conformation) is waived upon proof of neuter or spay, in which case the minimum (3) points may come from either Group C (performance) or Group D (tracking) or Group F (other)
3. Above fifteen (15) points must be obtained in no less than four (4) of the six (6) groups.
4. Points are not accumulative in any one group.
5. Dogs applying for the VGX must send copy of OFA certificate with official application. (Exception see: VGX requirement #2)
6. Applicants must use the official versatility application form submitted with the appropriate documentation sent to the Awards & Recognition Committee by May 1st
7. Open to all Wirehaired Pointing Griffons owned by AWPGA members in good standing.

For all NAVHDA test qualifications:

Photocopy of test record provided by NAVHDA

For all NSTRA trial points:

Photocopy of trial activity provided by NSTRA
